All employees and contractors are expected to co-operate with All Saints in the implementation of this Policy and the supporting Health, Safety and Environmental Management System and will ensure that their own work, so far as is reasonably practicable, is carried out with minimum risk to themselves or others.

Consultation with staff and operatives will be structured to ensure feedback is encouraged to continually improve safe systems of work.

The Health and Safety Policy is continually being monitored and developed and will be formally reviewed annually, though on exception amendments may be implemented at other times as required by legislative changes or work practices.
